Homework Challenge Autumn Term 1 2020

We would like children to select at least one of the homework challenges below for this term, however children can do as many as they wish. This will continue to be run alongside the regular reading, spelling, Maths and English homework that are set.

<p><u>History- Ancient Greece</u></p> <p>Create an Obstacle Course fit for a Spartan Warrior!</p> <p><i>The Spartans were excellent warriors. Can you make a 'training course' fit for a Spartan? You might include some sprinting, running, moving, lifting and jumping! Take some photos and most of all have fun!</i></p>	<p><u>Science – Life Cycles</u></p> <p>The Plant Life Cycle</p> <p><i>Plant a seed and watch it grow. You could take photos, write a diary or just observe your plant growing each day. Can you say which stage of the life cycle it is at as it grows?</i></p>	<p><u>Art – Still Life and Form</u></p> <p>Create a Still Life Sketch.</p> <p><i>Use some items in your home (e.g. fruit, tins, toys, anything that does not move) and place them in front of you. Sketch them, only what you can see from where you are sitting. Remember to use your careful cross-hatch technique to build form and tone.</i></p>
<p><u>R.E – Hinduism</u></p> <p>Draw a celebration that was special to you.</p> <p><i>Diwali is a special Hindu celebration. Can you think of a celebration that was special to you? Perhaps a birthday, wedding, christening or Christmas is very special to you. Have a go at drawing and writing some sentences about your special celebration! What did you eat? What did you wear? Who was there?</i></p>	<p><u>English – Warning Story</u></p> <p>Write a story where a character ignores a warning and finds themselves in some bother!</p> <p><i>Remember all the features you have learned to write a story. What character will you have? Where will your story be set? What will they be warned about? Will the problem have a resolution or will it be an unhappy ending?</i></p>	<p><u>Maths – Times Tables</u></p> <p>Times Tables Competition!</p> <p><i>Challenge a friend, a sibling, a parent or a grandparent to a Times Tables competition! Choose a times table (e.g. 5s), select an amount of time (e.g. 30 seconds) and see who can get the most correct in the time! Take photos, record your answers in a book or play on a whiteboard!</i></p>

The children will have their 'Homework Challenge book' to record their homework in if they wish. However, depending on the option they choose, the children may choose to record their homework in a different way that doesn't involve using their homework book. We do ask that everyone has a go at this homework so they all have something to share at the end of each term. We thank you for your continued support.
