### Homework Challenge – SPRING 2 2018

Building on the success of our homework challenge last year and the fantastic homework that the children completed, we move into the second Spring half term with our homework challenges. This type of homework really does motivate children and enhances their learning. We would like children to select at least one of the challenges below, however children can do as many as they wish. This will continue to be run alongside the regular reading, spellings and maths that are set. Examples of children's homework can be found on the website under the 'Gallery' section.

Our topic this term is 'The Good, the Bad and the Ugly' and the following are all ideas that tie in with the topic:

<p>One of the most famous outlaws was Robin Hood.</p> <p>Make a fact file or poster about him.</p>		<p>Policemen are sometimes known as 'bobbies' but do you know why? See if you can find out.</p>	<p>Imagine you are the first settlers on a new planet. Write a list of laws and their punishments!</p>	
<p>Sisyphus was punished by the gods. Can you find out about another person who was punished by God or the gods. You could create cartoon to tell the story.</p>		<p>Who do you think is a good person? What makes them good? Do they inspire others to do good?</p> <p>Create a portrait of them – you could paint, make a collage, use pencils or pastels. It could be colour or black and white. Be as creative as you can – try to capture their personality. This is a portrait in the style of Picasso.</p>	<p>Alternatively, who do you consider to be a villain? Can you think of a character in a book you have read – for example, Miss Trunchbull in Matilda or maybe He Who Must Not Be Named in Harry Potter? Make a mode or, portrait of them and explain why they are a BAD CHARACTER.</p>	

The challenge work for SPRING 2 is due in **Monday 26<sup>th</sup> March** and on **Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> March at 2:30pm** each child will get to present their work and for it to be celebrated. Parents are invited to this session too! **Please note that you will also have the valuable opportunity of looking through your child's topic portfolios to see what they have been learning in school.**

As we did last term, the children will have their 'Homework Challenge book'. We are expecting **one double page** to be used for each topic or you may choose to make a model, depending on the options available.

It is completely up to the children to decide how they want to record it. They could use photos, diagrams, drawings or something else! If you would like to do more than a double page then this is absolutely fine too. All we ask is that everyone has a go, so they all have something to share at the end of each term.
