PE Funding Report – September 2016

External Agencies

Through use of external agencies (Inspire Sports and Janis Baker), the children and staff have had the opportunity to take part in high quality teaching and learning.

During the lessons, teachers have observed and worked alongside sports coaches to develop their own skills and learn ideas for progressive activities in varied sports. This will have the long term effect of increasing PE teaching throughout the school.

The children benefited directly from high quality teaching of PE.

Resources

The purchase of resources has both replaced worn equipment and enabled the teaching of new sports.

Transport

Funding transport to and from sporting events has ensured that all children were able to take part, regardless of their family's financial situation.

2016/17

In this coming year we will continue to fund external agencies to further develop high quality teaching and learning throughout the school.

We shall be extending this use of external agencies to after school extra-curricular clubs – whereby we shall be subsidising the cost of new clubs to make them affordable to all children, regardless of their family's financial circumstances. This is expected to increase participation in sport and introduce new sports to children at West Lynn.

This year we have bought into the West Norfolk School Sports Partnership. This includes festivals for children in EYFS and key stage 1, competitions for children in key stage 2 and CPD for teachers and support staff. This will further increase the numbers of children taking part in festivals and competitive sport, as well as providing training for staff to develop their skills.

We shall be further extending our range of sports to include tri-golf – introducing children at West Lynn to a new sport.

We shall be developing outdoor storage to enable us to have space to store the new equipment for new sports. This will involve purchase and insulation of an outdoor metal shed and will have the effect of prolonging the life of outdoor equipment.

We shall use funding to purchase new team kits for the children – this will give the children a greater sense of pride when representing their school, as well as encouraging new children to take part. We shall also be funding appropriate wear for staff.

We shall again be funding transport to ensure all children are able to take part in sporting activities.
